Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF THE HIGHWAY BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES

- LOCATION:** Kingston Blount & Crowell, B4009 site-25
- REASON:** Carriageway surface dressing works
- DURATION:** Starting on 5 June 2025
The anticipated end date of this closure is 8 June 2025
(each day from 04:00hrs to 18:00hrs) date include

(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)
- ACCESS:** Limited access will be maintained for local buses, emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: The alternative route for traffic for is via a combination of B4009 – B4445 – B4012 – A40 – B4009 and vice-versa.
