Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

**TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY  
BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES**

**LOCATION:** Kingston Blount, B4009 ( Kingston Hill to A40)

**REASON:** To facilitate surface dressing works

**DURATION:** Starting on 26 April 2026  
The completion date is 30 April 2026 (date included)  
This will operate between 04:00 and 18:00  
(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)

**ACCESS:** limited access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works. Access will be maintained for cyclists and pedestrians

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

**SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE:** via Kingston Hill, A40 and vice versa
