The **Chinnor Village Centre**, a not for profit charity, offers a place and space for the use of the local community; focused on the provision of care and companionship. The **Village Centre** is an inclusive venue; a central meeting point for a variety of activities allowing our community to connect and socialise; nurturing a sense of community spirit, belonging and homeliness.

For example, the **Village Centre** provides a Friendship Club, a Stroke Club and facilitates a Dementia Café (FMKC) and recently a Parkinson's group representing the essence of the charity. Engagement with the community is supported by volunteers assisting in various tasks from befriending to supporting individuals with recreational activities and providing refreshments. Referrals to the services are accepted from individuals, family members and social/healthcare agencies; priority is always given to ensure the services the **Village Centre** provides are all inclusive.

The charity has three main activities:

1. The Coffee Shop
2. Day Care & Mini-Bus
3. Room Hire



The Coffee Shop is a comfy, welcoming haven in the middle of Chinnor High Street; the perfect place to enjoy coffee, breakfast, lunch or a mid morning or afternoon snack. We are open six days per week; 9.00-16.00 Monday-Friday and 09.30-1400 on Saturday. Sue, Tina and the Coffee Shop team are ready to welcome you!

Day Care offers personalised care and activities for older people and for example, stroke recoverees who would enjoy and benefit from socialising and companionship out in the community. We have trained care staff on site who aim to give attendees the chance to relax, socialise and have some fun!
